

We are returning this year to Girton, a large college founded in 1869 originally as a ladies' college and set in 50 acres of trees and grassland on the northern edge of Cambridge.

There is car parking at the rear of the College approached via Girton Road, off Huntingdon Road. Location maps will be provided for those booking for the conference. Taxis are available immediately outside Cambridge Station.

The venue gives us a choice of *en suite* accommodation in the new inner building, Ash Court, which has some ground floor bedrooms and with the upper floors accessible by lift; or non-*en suite* accommodation in the original building which has a few rooms on the ground floor and some on upper floors without a lift. Please note that the ground floor non-*en suite* rooms have hand-basins, showers and toilets across the corridor from the bedrooms. The first and second floor non-*en suite* rooms have hand-basins in the rooms, with showers and toilets in the corridors. Please see scale of fees opposite, and **please remember to indicate on the booking your request for *en suite* or non-*en suite* bedroom, ground floor, etc.**

There are some long corridors to negotiate for some of our various meeting and dining rooms, the chapel etc., but all are inside the College; so there is no need for any walking outside for our set activities. Our various venue rooms will be signposted, and a College plan provided. The College's modern heated swimming pool and facilities within the building may be available for us to use.

The College management requires precise numbers for each night and every meal/coffee/tea etc. Please indicate everything required and mention any special dietary needs (including vegetarian). Breakfasts and lunches will be from the self-service buffet/servery but both dinners (two courses plus coffee) will be served at the table.

The last date by which bookings can be accepted is **Tuesday 8th August**, but you are advised to book as soon as possible so that all requirements can be communicated to the College well in advance and to their deadline.

To reserve a place **please send a deposit of £50 (or the full amount)**. It may not be possible to return your deposit if the booking is cancelled after the closing date, although every effort will be made. If a deposit is sent, please send the balance by 8th August.

If an e-mail address is given, the booking will be acknowledged by e-mail. Otherwise, please enclose a small stamped & addressed envelope for the initial booking acknowledgement.
