- ₱ Practical support and assistance, as well as general advice, when parish/benefice vacancies arise. The Society will forward details of your church to its confidential list of approximately 100 licensed and/or beneficed clergy who have requested to be kept informed of vacancies, and who range in age from their twenties upwards. With PBS Corporate Membership highlighted in advertisements and parish profiles, clergy who are enthusiastic about the BCP will be encouraged to apply, while those who are not will be discouraged.
- ♣ Help and information via the PBS office with general queries relating to the Book of Common Prayer;
- Membership brochures to encourage members of the congregation to support the PBS through individual membership alongside your church's Corporate Membership. These are supplied in acrylic table-top stands which can be placed at the back of church or wherever convenient to catch the attention of parishioners and visitors.

What does it cost, and what is the money used for?

The suggested annual subscription is £50, which helps to support the Society's work with:

№ Ordinands:

The approximately 600 ordinands who enter training every year in the Church of England each receive a personal copy of the Prayer Book, supported by a manual on using the BCP and specially-commissioned 'how-to' videos available online.

Workshops and seminars for ordinands are held close to their training establishments. Presented by clergy who are enthusiastic users of the BCP, they extol the value of the resources it contains for practical ministry.

The PBS offers bursaries to ordinands to attend the Society's Annual Conference, which provides an opportunity to hear a variety of distinguished speakers.

№ Parish clergy:

Working through ministerial training organisers in the dioceses, the PBS offers assistance to new and established clergy. In addition, clergy are also eligible to apply for the Conference bursaries.

★ Licensed Readers:

The PBS recognises that Readers—especially in country parishes—are most likely to be required to conduct Morning or Evening Prayer services. The Society seeks to support them by organising day courses especially for them.
