

Richard Chartres was ordained in 1974, and served as Chaplain to the Archbishop of Canterbury, Robert Runcie. In 1987, he became Professor of Divinity at Gresham College, London, before being nominated as Bishop of Stepney in 1992. Three years later he became Bishop of London, a post he held until his retirement in 2017.

A passionate advocate of the BCP, he has served as Ecclesiastical Patron of the PBS for over 30 years.

The Revd Paul Thomas is Vicar of St James', Sussex Gardens, Paddington, and a former Deputy Chairman of the Prayer Book Society.

He served for 10 years as a member of the Church of England's Liturgical Commission (2006-2016) and is the author of *Using the Book of Common Prayer: A Simple Guide*, a copy of which is presented by the PBS to every ordinand in training.


