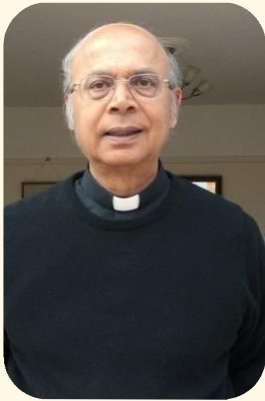

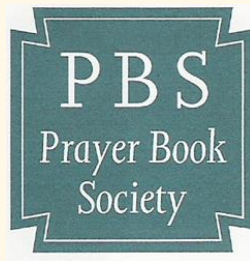
Prior to Evensong members may wish to have a cup of Tea and have a Guided Tour of Stanway House led by The Earl of Wemyss and March DL.

Stanway House

Stanway House:

An outstanding example of a Jacobean Cotswold manor owned for 800 years by Tewkesbury Abbey and then by for nearly 500 years by the Tracy family and their descendants, the Earls of Wemyss and March. The famous Stanway Fountain rises to over 300 feet, making it the tallest fountain in Britain and the tallest gravity-fed fountain in the world. The Gatehouse dates from about 1630 and the Tithe Barn from about 1370.

Lord Charteris:

One of the founders and former President of the Prayer Book Society, the late Rt Hon Lord Charteris of Amisfield GCB GCVO OBE PC (1913—1999), is buried in the Churchyard. Lord Charteris was Assistant Private Secretary and then Private Secretary to Her Majesty The Queen from 1952 to 1977. He was Provost of Eton from 1978 to 1991. Lord Charteris was an uncle of the present Lord Wemyss.
